Gather Harcourt, August 2022 will be run by the Harcourt Progress Association Inc. (HPA) in conjunction with the Harcourt Applefest Committee. Stall fees for this Gather will be used to support Applefest 2023. Funds generated from the HPA Bar will be used to support future community events and projects.

Selection criteria

- Locally based we'll preference local, then those from our region more broadly
- Local products we'll preference stallholders who use local products
- Handcrafted we'll preference handcrafted, especially locally made
- Products that celebrate our region extra points if your products are specific to our region

We'll endeavor have a range of stalls, with a maximum of two stalls selling the same, or similar products.

Please note deadlines for fee payment. This helps us build a financially sustainable event and makes budgeting easier. If we have to cancel the event due to extreme weather or fire danger, we'll refund any pre-paid fees in full.
